KTI Impact Awards 2021

When can I make my submissions?

Submissions can be made between 21st June to 3rd September 2021.

How can submissions be made?

Submissions must be made using the link to the online form. This link will be circulated to all TTOs by email on 22nd June. Forms will also be available on the KTI website. Note: All submissions this year must be accompanied by an Elevator Pitch which is to be emailed to KTI separately to awards@knowledgetransferireland.com at the time of submitting the written form.

What is the timeline during which submissions are eligble?

Submissions made will detail impact or success that has taken place in the time period 1^{st} January $2020 - 31^{st}$ July 2021. The submission being nominated may have originated prior to 2020.

How many submissions can a HEI make under each category?

HEIs are permitted to make <u>one submission per category</u> i.e. a maximum total number of 3 submissions can be received per HEI. That is, one in the Industry Engagement Award category, one under the Commercialisation Award category and one in the Future Forward Award category.

How should a joint submission be made in the case of two HEIs having worked together?

Where there is a joint submission, one HEI is to take the lead and make the submission in their name. That becomes the lead HEI's submission whilst the second HEI is permitted to make their own submission within that same category should they so wish. The lead HEI is to be agreed between the two partners in question.

Who should deliver the elevator pitch?

The elevator pitch should be delivered by just one person. This person can be either the TTO Director or the Case Manager.

How will the awards ceremony run this year?

The awards ceremony will take the form of a virtual event to be held on 25th November. The event will take place during working hours. Further details will follow closer to the time.
